GUIDELINES

OUR Credit Union will grant one \$1000 Scholarship to an individual who has graduated high school prior to the application deadline. There are no age limitations for qualification. Those who meet the following criteria may apply:

- 1. Applicants must be a member of OUR Credit Union.*
- **2.** Applicants must be pursuing their education at an accredited institution, trade school, vocational school, community college or university.
- **3.** Applicants must be accepted by the school and plan to be enrolled, at minimum, as a part-time student (6 credit hours).
- **4.** Applicants who have been awarded an OUR Credit Union Scholarship in the past may not apply.

ONE LETTER OF RECOMMENDATION

The letter should be recent, signed and address why the applicant deserves the scholarship as well as elaborate the applicant's character and accomplishments.

RESUME

Include an updated, typed copy of your resume. Resumes will be reviewed similar to a resume being considered for employment.

ESSAY

Selection criteria will include: ideas/content, organization, sentence fluency, word choice and grammar. The essay should be approximately 500 words, typed, double spaced in 12 pt font.

Essay Topic: Discuss in your essay any challenges or obstacles you have dealt with and overcome in life and how this will (or has) help(ed) you succeed in college and beyond.

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The scholarship recipient will be notified by April 23, 2021. This scholarship is available for tuition, books and fees. At OUR Credit Union's discretion, the scholarship will be paid directly to the educational institution the student is attending, the scholarship recipient, or recipient's guardian. The awards will be paid upon receiving a bill or paid receipt.
