GUIDELINES

OUR Credit Union will grant one \$1000 Scholarship to an individual who has graduated high school prior to the application deadline. There are no age limitations for qualification. Those who meet the following criteria may apply:

1. Applicants must be a member of OUR Credit Union.*
2. Applicants must be pursuing their education at an accredited institution, trade school, vocational school, community college or university.
3. Applicants must be accepted by the school and plan to be enrolled, at minimum, as a part-time student (6 credit hours).
4. Applicants who have been awarded an OUR Credit Union Scholarship in the past may not apply.

Please include the following items with your completed application:

- One Recent Letter of Recommendation
- Two non-family references (Listed on Application - Name, Phone and Email)
- Résumé
- 250-500 Word Essay - see below for details and topic
- List of Community Involvement and School Related Involvement

ONE LETTER OF RECOMMENDATION

The written recommendation can be from a past or present employer, coach, teacher, instructor, counselor, community leader, etc., but must be written by an unrelated adult. The letter should be recent, signed and address why the applicant deserves the scholarship as well as elaborate the applicant's character and accomplishments.

RÉSUMÉ

Include an updated, typed copy of your résumé. Résumés will be reviewed similar to a résumé being considered for employment.

ESSAY

Selection criteria will include: ideas/content, organization, sentence fluency, word choice and grammar. The essay should be 250-500 words, typed, double spaced in 12 pt font.

Essay Topic: What are your most important extracurricular or community activities? What made you join or participate in these activities? What made you continue to contribute to them?

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*Applicants may not use a guardian's member number.

The scholarship recipient will be notified by April 15, 2019. This scholarship is available for tuition, books and fees. At OUR Credit Union's discretion, the scholarship will be paid directly to the educational institution the student is attending, the scholarship recipient, or recipient's guardian. The awards will be paid upon receiving a bill or paid receipt.
